



WellPoint Internship Program FAQ

Q. How do I apply for an internship?

- A. Please visit our website at <http://www.wellpoint.com/careers> and type “intern” or “college” into the Keyword Search field to view our most current internships. If there is a position that matches your interests and studies, please complete a profile online or apply directly to that position. If we see a match, we will contact you.

Q. Are there basic prerequisites for an internship?

- A. Applicants for internships must be at least 18 years of age and currently enrolled in a US college or university and, in most cases, be able to receive credit for their internship. Also, prospects of securing an internship will be improved if you have already acquired “transferable” knowledge during other internships or related professional experiences. For actuarial students, having at least one exam under your belt by the time you interview with us will be to your advantage.

Q. What type of interns do you hire?

- A. We typically hire interns in the areas of actuarial, finance/auditing, internal consulting and information technology, but we hire in all areas of the company as the internships become available. We also offer both paid and unpaid internships. Paid internships salaries vary per hour, depending upon the position and location. Unpaid interns must be eligible to earn academic credit in the form of units and must have proof before the start date of the internship.

Q. Where are your internships located?

- A. WellPoint has office locations across the United States from New York to Los Angeles and from Milwaukee to Atlanta, click on a point on our locations map to get more information about all of our many office locations: <http://www.careersatwellpoint.com/careers-locations.asp>

Q. How long are your internships/co-ops?

- A. They can last anywhere from three months full-time during the summer or on part-time basis during the school year. Our co-ops typically last six months.
